

TREE PIT SURFACING

SURFACING CHOICES

Stone used for Tree pit surfacing is always open graded between 5-10mm usually in 25kg bags. The stone must have been washed and dried and must not contain extraneous material that will cause surface staining. There are several suppliers of suitable stone in the UK.

The stone used is normally crushed granite or rounded stone with a high 'voids' content.

If rounded stone is used it may be advisable to apply a surface scatter of crushed fine glass or aluminium oxide to improve slip resistance.

Tree pit surfacing is not intended to receive any more than very occasional loading from pedestrians. If in a highly pedestrianised area a smaller stone should be considered.
